WHEREAS:

BANESCO (PANAMÁ), S.A. is a bank duly organized and existing in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Panama, authorized to engage in the banking business in or from the Republic of Panama under a General Banking License granted through Resolution SBP 009-2007, dated 5th February 2007.

BANESCO (PANAMÁ), S.A., in compliance with Article 58 (2) of the Banking Law, has requested this Superintendency to authorize the temporary closure of the Via España Branch, District of Panama, Panama City, starting on 19 August 2024, due to temporary remodeling for an approximate period of three (3) months, ending around mid-November this year.

According with the provisions of Article 16(I)(2) of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for the relocation of banking establishments, and

After conducting the relevant analysis, the request submitted by **BANESCO** (**PANAMÁ**), **S.A.** did not raise any objections.

RESOLVES:

<u>SOLE ARTICLE</u>: To authorize **BANESCO** (**PANAMÁ**), S.A. to proceed with the temporary closure of the Via España Branch, District of Panama, Panama City.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Article Article 58(2) and 16(I)(2) of the Banking Law.
